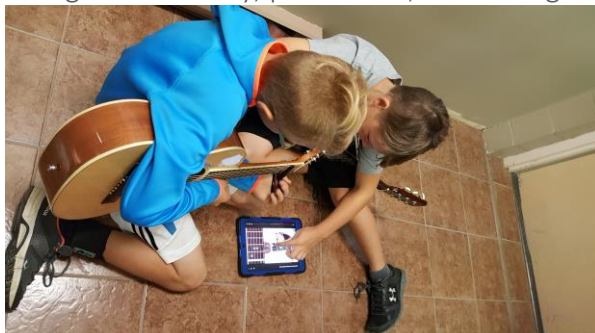
WOWZERS!

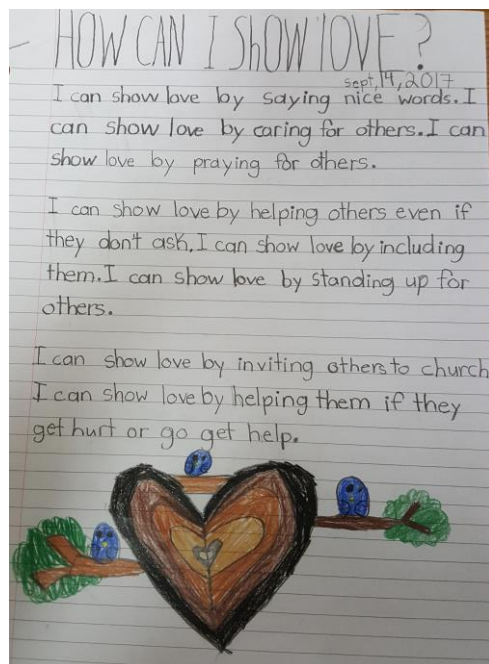
SERVANT'S HEART

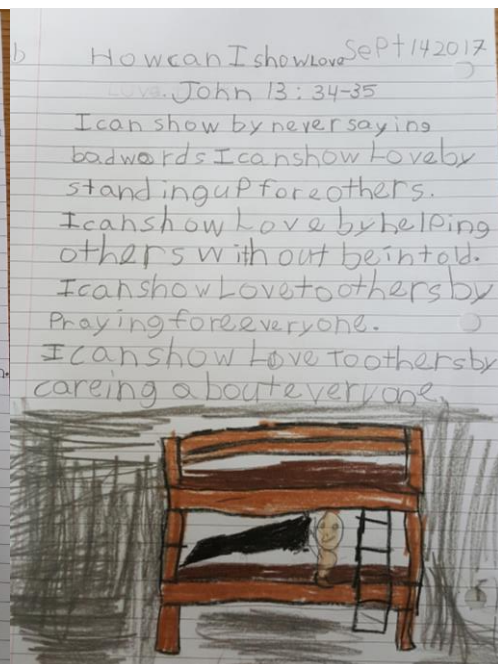
